Overall progress of pupils in Key Stage 4


- 70% of pupils are making expected progress or above expected progress in English
- 75% of pupils are making expected progress or above expected progress in Mathematics
- 75% of pupils were assessed as being 'partially engaged' none were described as being 'fully' engaged
- 30% of pupils were described as being 'highly' impacted as a result of the pandemic

Key Stage 4

For the purpose of this dataset there are **20** pupils in the cohort, **14** of which are **male** accounting for **70%** of the population, **6** are **female** accounting **30%** of the population.


English

6 pupils were assessed as **working towards** their targets, 14 pupils were assessed as **working within** their targets and 0 were assessed as **exceeding** their targets. By gender there were 5 males and 1 female **working towards** their targets and 9 males and 5 females **working within** their targets no pupil in this cohort were assessed as **exceeding** their targets



Maths

5 pupils were assessed as **working towards** their targets, 15 pupils were assessed as **working within** their targets and 0 were assessed as **exceeding** their targets. 10 Males and 5 females were seen to be **working within** their targets and again none were demonstrating as **exceeding** their targets in this subject.



Conclusion

Key stage 4 pupils were the best performing cohort across the school, followed by Pupil Premium children.
